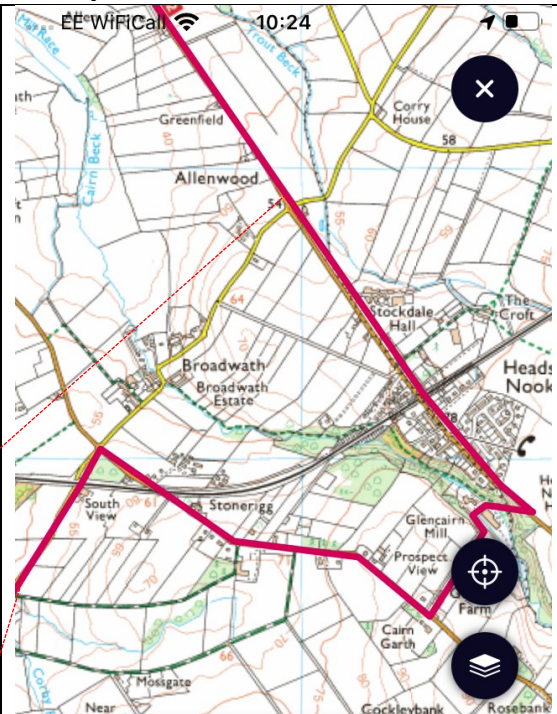


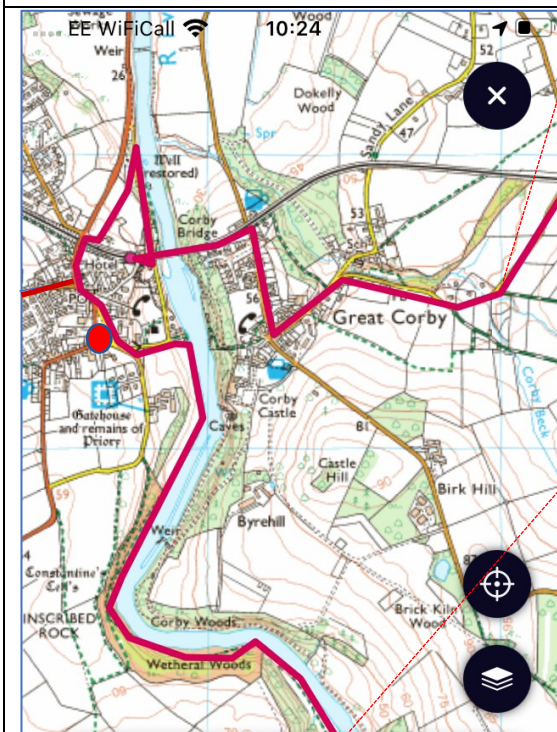
The COP Nature Appreciation Walk route 6th September 2021 Eden Wild Goose



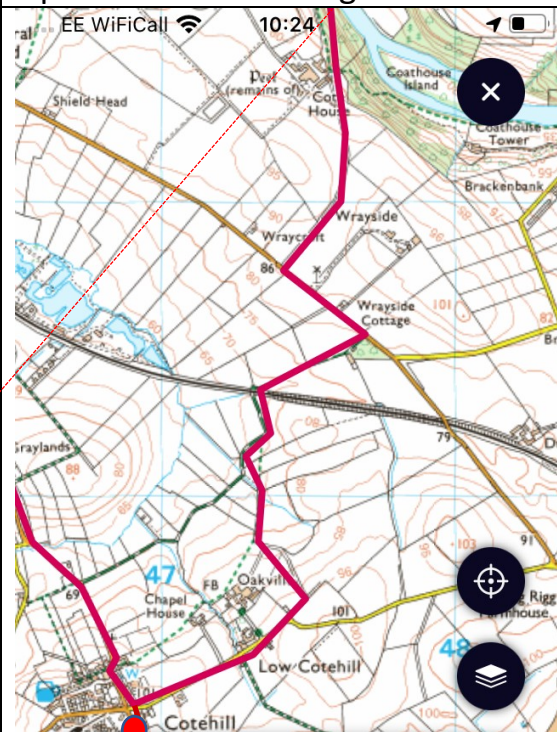
1/ 8.30am Leave St Paul's Holme Eden Pass through Little Corby and Corby Hill.



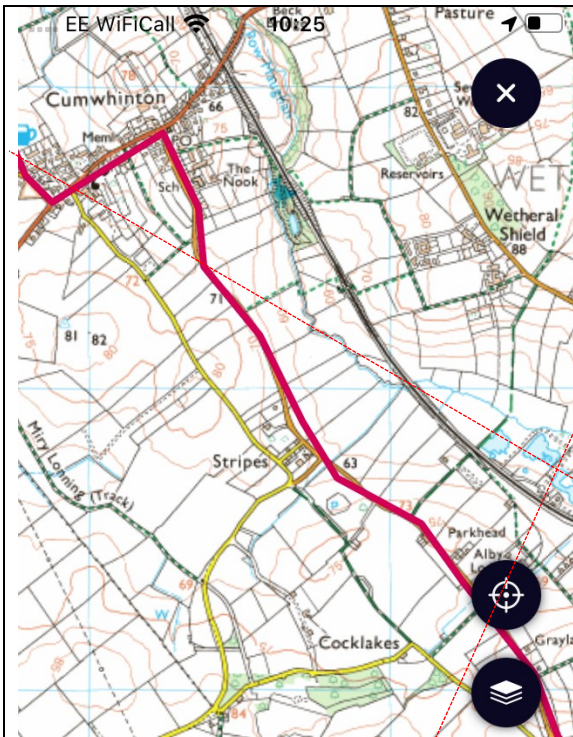
2/ Through Heads Nook to the woodland footpath to Cairn Beck. Up to the road leading to Great Corby.



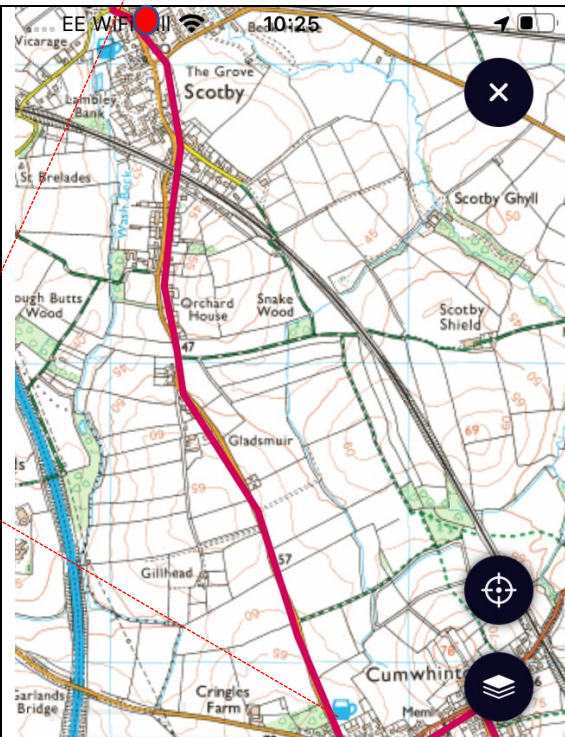
3/ Cross the viaduct to the station. Down the 99 steps to St Cuthbert's Well. To Wetheral Methodist Chapel and arrive on the Green for coffee about 10.30-11am (Stop 1) ● Head down to the river past Holy Trinity Wetheral and continue to St Constantine's Cave



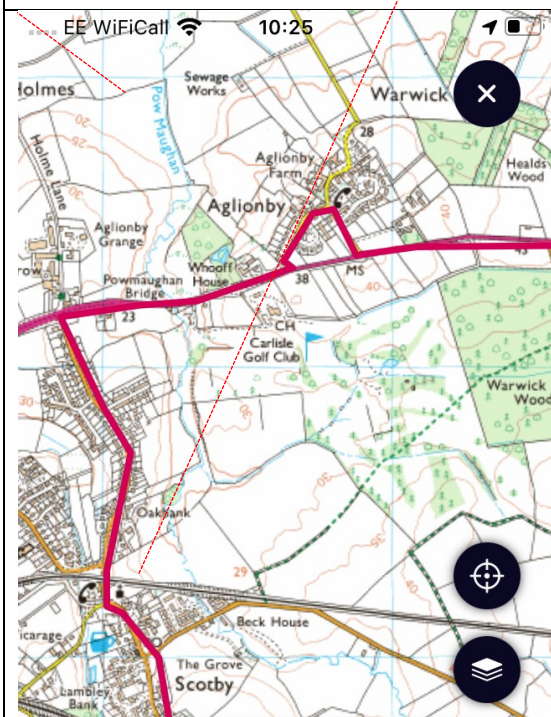
4/ Follow the course of the Eden going south before joining the road to Cotehill. Arrive in Cotehill for 1-1.30pm, picnic lunch in St John's churchyard. (Stop 2) ●



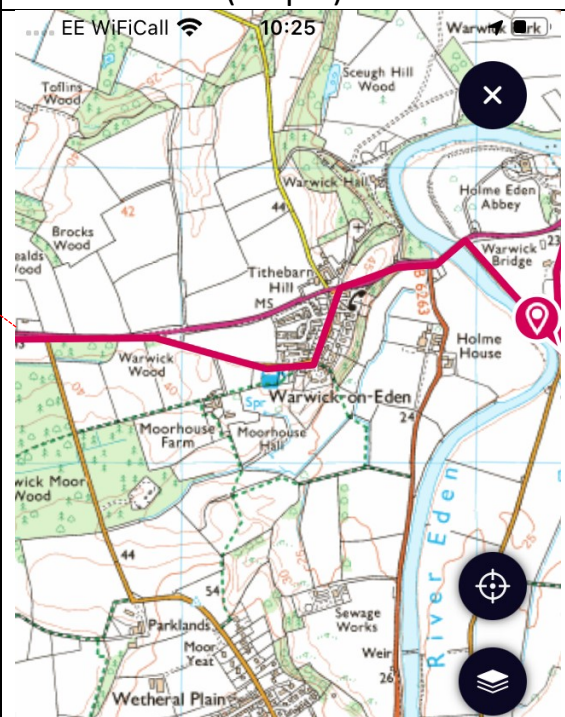
5/ Head up the road to Cumwhinton

Turn East on the A69
and loop into Aglionby



8/ Walk through Warwick on Eden
and arrive back at start about 5pm
