<i>Armillaria gallica</i>	Bulbous honey fungus	
<i>Clavulinopsis corniculata</i>	a coral	
<i>Clavulinopsis luteoalba</i>	Apricot club	Pallid tip to yellow club
<i>Cordyceps militaris</i>	Scarlet caterpillar club	Parasitises pupae of moths buried in soil
<i>Cuphophyllus pratensis</i>	Meadow waxcap	
<i>Cuphophyllus virgineus</i>	Snowy waxcap	
<i>Cuphophyllus colemanniana</i>	Toasted waxcap	Brown. Fishy smell
<i>Cystoderma amianthinum</i>	Earthy powdercap	
<i>Dermoloma cuneifolium</i>	Crazed cap	drab with crazing on cap. Smells mealy
<i>Entoloma sericeum</i>	Silky pinkgill	Strong mealy/floury smell, sinuate gills.
<i>Galerina</i> sp	Bell	
<i>Geoglossum</i> sp	Earth-tongue	
<i>Gliophorus psittacina</i>	Parrot waxcap	Green colour present somewhere on stalk or cap
<i>Hygrocybe ceracea</i>	Butter waxcap	
<i>Hygrocybe chlorophana</i>	Golden waxcap	
<i>Hygrocybe coccinea</i>	Scarlet waxcap	
<i>Hygrocybe quieta</i>	Oily waxcap	
<i>Hygrocybe reidii</i>	Honey waxcap	Smells of honey
<i>Hygrocybe vitellina</i>		Slimy yellow cap. Decurrent gills with gelatinous edges
<i>Laccaria laccata</i>	Deceiver	Stipe is lined, wide spaced gills, gills pinkish tinge
<i>Macrocystidia cucumis</i>	Cucumber cap	Dark brown, velvety cap and stipe. Smell of cucumber or fish
<i>Mycena aetites</i>	Bonnet	
<i>Mycena filopes</i>	Iodine Bonnet	CHECK. Small <i>Mycena</i> from grassland

Parasite of trees

Thin, black crust, generally on beech
Steely grey colour when young
White, translucent jelly fungus on dead wood

Olive cap and lilac stalk
Interveining between gills

Cap and stalk are orangey brown but base of stem is black
